OK, so it should be gold, frankincense and myrrh. The SIBA Scotland bottled beer championship was held at the Beehive Inn, Edinburgh on Friday 18 November this year. We are pleased to announce that all three permanent bottled beers we entered all won awards in what was an extremely competitive event. We received **Gold** for Blackfriar in the bottled bitters over 5% ABV. Ossian received a **silver** in the bottled gold beers category, and Lia Fail a **bronze** in bottled bitter up to 4.9%.

Commenting on the results, Head Brewer Ken Duncan said 'we take great pride in our range of bottled beers and these awards underline how highly they are regarded'. He went on 'with our most recent bottling of Santa's Swallie now on shelf we can offer our customers a complete range of award-winning bottled beers. One way kegs

As you may know, one of the major problems any brewery faces is the return of its empty containers. A huge amount of working capital is tied up in empty casks and kegs sitting outside pubs or in yards up and down the country. The return of kegs is a particular problem if a brewery wants to develop overseas draught sales. That is why we are developing beer in 'petainers', a keg that can be shipped, served, and then fully recycled like any other PET bottle. This Czech development has proved very successful in local markets and there are plans afoot to have them manufactured in the UK too. As the trade becomes increasingly environmentally friendly one-way kegs may soon feature heavily in a pub cellar here and abroad.



Lia Fail to be available in draught... in Kuala Lumpur!

Our first shipment of beer to Malaysia left the brewery on 23 November on a 32 day voyage. Lia Fail, Ossian, Blackfriar and Santa's Swallie will be on the bar in Kuala Lumpur just in time for Hogmanay. And it is not just bottles. Lia Fail will be made available in draught to expats and locals alike. We have shipped a number of 30 litre 'one-way kegs which will give our customer the chance to serve draught beer without worrying about return of the kegs.' Selamat Tahun Baru !!
